CINCINNATI IS THE FIRST 2030 DISTRICT TO ESTABLISH A DISTRICT-WIDE HEALTHY BUILDING MODEL

This innovative model, created by the Cincinnati 2030 District, responds to regional health needs and chronic diseases such as heart disease, cancer, asthma and diabetes by promoting healthy behaviors and building performance. In collaboration with the International WELL Building Institute, and using the local Community Health Needs Assessment, this program uses the building blocks of the WELL Building Standard and targets the unique health needs of the Greater Cincinnati community.
